Designed by Keith Bradley of award-winning practice Feilden Clegg Bradley, the home will be vastly different from most other 21st-century houses. Its scale compares with some of the biggest country houses in history. "The floor area of about 40,000 sq ft is about the same as Castle Howard or Hardwick Hall," says Bradley. Not only will the roof of the two-winged home be covered in grasses, but more than half its energy needs will be provided by bio-crops grown on the estate.
